Incoming freshman Chemistry Students

ACT 20 or equivalent SAT

GPA 3.2 or better and has passed Mathematics and Chemistry Classes

Transfer Chemistry Students

Must have 3.0 or better GPA

Has been on track to obtain a Chemistry Degree

Award Amount

1. Research Scholarship: \$1000 per semester. Student will work with a faculty for 6 hours per week to help the faculty in the laboratory. The student will be evaluated at the end of each semester and must maintain a 3.0 or better GPA to receive award for the following semester.
2. Work-Study Scholarship: \$2000 per semester: Student will work in the Chemistry Storeroom for \$10 per hour and about 12 hours per week. The student will be evaluated at the end of each semester and must maintain a 3.0 or better GPA to receive award for the following semester.

Award Duration: Two Years. Students are expected to compete for other scholarships available at the University and from external sources.
